What's New in 2019

All Species

- All Animals will enter the grounds at Gates 4 or 6. Gate 4 will be open 24/7
- Health Papers will be checked at this time. All animals must have a valid Health Paper with Official Identification (including transit animals).
- Sale of Champions Auction will not be conducted. Additional premium will be awarded to Champion and Reserve Market Animals to equal the amount traditionally received from the Sale of Champions.

Dairy Cattle

- All Dairy Cattle will be required to have a USDA 840 EID Tag. This includes all transit and sale cattle. *You can purchase 840 EID tags on the NAILE website at livestockexpo.org under Premium Book General Information*
- Herd Units will be allowed 2 wild card substitutions per breed
- Tack space will be available for purchase- \$25/tie
 - Stalling request form will be available online. – Request needs to be made **per string**
- ***2020 Requirement*** All dairy cattle shall be reported negative on an ELISA or PCR BVD-PI test that has been collected by an accredited veterinarian. The results and date of the test should be recorded on the CVI issued for entry onto the KEC for the NAILE.

Dairy Goats

- Nigerian Dwarf goats will have their own breed show for 2019.
- LaMancha goats will show in the All Other Purebreds for 2019.
- Exhibitors will be allowed 1 wild card substitution

Beef Cattle

- All Beef Cattle will be required to have a USDA 840 EID Tag. This includes all transit and sale cattle. *You can purchase 840 EID tags on the NAILE website at livestockexpo.org under Premium Book General Information*
- All beef cattle shall be reported negative on an ELISA or PCR BVD-PI test that has been collected by an accredited veterinarian. The results and date of the test shall be recorded on the CVI issued for entry onto the KEC for the NAILE.
- All Open Show Bulls will be weighed prior to entry in the show ring. Heifers may be weighed as well up to the discretion of the Breed Association and will be published in the Premium Book.
- Feeder Calf Show-
 - All entries will be singles, both Steers and Heifers
 - Sale will be optional at the time of entry. 40 head must be consigned at time of entry for the sale to be conducted.
 - Entry fee - \$50.
- Steer Show
 - Grand Champion to receive \$20,000
 - Reserve Grand Champion to receive \$10,000

- Grand and Reserve will remain terminal
- Junior Heifer Show
 - Electronic Papers will be accepted at check in.
 - If the electronic papers are not tattoo verified- heifer must have her tattoos checked at check in.

Meat Goats

- JABGA sanctioned show will be held in 2019- \$2,500 added Premiums

 - Market Goat Show
 - Grand Champion will receive \$8,000

- All online sales must be held in conjunction with a live sale.
- Market Lambs
 - Blackface Crossbred will be divided into divisions, those divisions will then compete for Champion Blackface Crossbred.
 - Dorper Division will be added
 - Top 5 Market Lambs will be selected
 - Grand Champion to receive \$12,000
 - Reserve Grand Champion to receive \$10,000
 - 3rd Overall to receive \$5,000
 - 4th Overall to receive \$2,000
 - 5th Overall to receive \$1,000
 - Grand and Reserve will remain terminal. 3rd – 5th Non terminal

- Buyer will be available if you wish to sell your hogs
- All swine are required to have a USDA 840 EID Tag. Including all transit animals *You can purchase 840 EID tags on the NAILE website at livestockexpo.org under Premium Book General Information*
- Tamworth breed will be accepted.
 - AOB division will be for any breed that has less than 15 head checked in.
- Top 5 Market Hogs will be selected
 - Grand Champion will receive \$12,000
 - Reserve Grand Champion will receive \$10,000
 - 3rd Overall will receive \$5,000
 - 4th Overall will receive \$2,000
 - 5th Overall will receive \$1,000
 - Grand and Reserve will remain terminal. 3rd – 5th Non-terminal
